The First Responder Awareness training course is designed for individuals who are likely to witness or discover a hazardous substance release and be able to initiate an emergency response action by notifying the proper authorities of the release. Training topics include:

- Introduction to hazardous materials;
- Risks associated with a hazardous materials release/incident;
- Recognition and identification of hazardous substances;
- Scene management; and
- Health and safety.

Target Audience: Tribal Police, Forest Service, Highway/Transportation Workers, Public Works, Tribal Rangers, EMTs, Community Members, Environmental Personnel, and other personnel that respond to emergencies on Tribal lands.

The training is sponsored by the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (ITCA) Environmental Quality Programs. A Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) grant enables us to provide the EPCRA training at no cost to participants.
