Thank you for your participation in the Older Americans Act of 1965 - Title III Program. The Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc., Area Agency on Aging, Region 8 (ITCA-AAA) scheduled a public hearing for Tuesday, October 16, 2018 from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M., to be held at the Ge' Gelik Ha Ki Elderly Center in Maricopa, AZ.

The Ak-Chin Indian Community receives a Title III grant from the Administration on Aging (AOA) through the Department of Economic Security, Division of Aging and Adult Services (DES-DAAS) to provide nutrition and other supportive services to elders who qualify. One requirement of the grant is to conduct at least one public hearing per year on the previous year's budget, spending and accomplishments for the period of July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.

The purpose of the public hearing is to provide an opportunity to comment on current aging issues as a way to improve future service delivery to elders, disabled adults and family caregivers.
