

Change of Minimum Stock Requirement for Infant fruits and vegetables

Effective February 15, 2015, minimum stock requirements for infant fruits and vegetables will change to the following:

Food Item	Brand/Type	Quantities Required to Stock	Size	# of varieties	Not allowed
Infant Fruits and Vegetables	Any Brand Stage 2, any single variety or combination of plain fruits or vegetables in 4 oz. containers	128 containers	4 ounce containers can be single containers, 2-packs or both	4 varieties of fruits and 4 varieties of vegetables	No infant fruits and vegetables with added salt, sugar or starches, desserts, dinners or food combinations, meat sticks or organic infant meats.

Changes:

- 3.5 ounce 2-pack containers are no longer apart of the minimum stock requirements due to Gerber® discontinuing the 3.5 ounce 2-packs. Gerber will be increasing the size of 2-packs to (2) 4ounce containers.
- Quantities of 4ounce containers has been increased to 128 containers, this includes both single and double packages of 4 ounce infant fruits and vegetables.
- 4 varieties of vegetables and 4 varieties of fruits are required to meet minimum stock requirements.

NOTE: Changes to minimum stock requirements will be effective **February 15, 2015**, to remain in compliance with the ITCA WIC Program, changes need to be implanted on or before February 15, 2015.
