At the invitation of a Tribe in Arizona, the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (ITCA) Tribal Epidemiology Center (TEC) will provide a 4-hour instruction on the Arizona Crash Report and supplemental forms. The following topics will be emphasized through a PowerPoint presentation:

2. Federal database of crashes
3. Traffic records
4. Model Minimum Uniform Crash Criteria
5. Arizona's Crash Report Form Instruction Manual
6. Arizona Crash Report
7. Supplemental forms to the Arizona Crash Report
8. ITCA Data Sharing Agreement

BACKGROUND

To assist Tribes in Arizona to utilize standard reporting forms for motor vehicle crashes occurring on tribal lands, ITCA created this training. An instructor provides background on the federal guidance for crash reporting, reviews each of the 34 sections of the Arizona Crash Report, and highlights the Fatal Supplemental Form, Occupant Supplemental Form, and the Truck/Bus Supplemental Form and Diagram Sheet.
