Why: SHIP Counselors will be able to assist elders, caregivers and people with disabilities by offering benefits assistance and cost savings information, that could potentially help pay for medical costs & daily living expenses. In addition, benefits such as Medicare and Medicaid contribute to Indian Health Services revenue, leading to expanded services.
