EPIDEMIOLOGIST II - SYPHILIS & CONGENITAL SYPHILIS PREVENTION

Annual Salary: \$47K-\$50K (DOE) Benefits: Medical, Dental, Basic Life & 401(k)

Under the general supervision of the TEC Program Manager at the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. (ITCA), the Epidemiologist II effectively provides Tribes in Arizona, Nevada, and Utah with epidemiologic expertise regarding infectious disease data collection, analysis, interpretation, quality improvement, dissemination, and disease prevention and control. The Epidemiologist II will serve as the health promotion lead for the TEC Syphilis & Congenital Syphilis support by providing technical assistance and training to support Tribal projects. Timely and regular attendance to work and work-related events is an essential function of this position.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: This list is not all inclusive of the duties and responsibilities and/or skills, knowledge, and abilities of this position.

- Manage the TEC Syphilis & Congenital Syphilis project by planning the project, monitoring progress, and seeking ways to improve the project to assist the Tribes.
- Assist the Tribes to plan, administer and promote the health improvement activities in accordance with the ITCA procedures and guidelines and funding terms and conditions.
- Assist Tribes with project scope of work development and Memorandum of Agreement construction.
- Assist the Tribes, as needed, to develop a syphilis and congenital syphilis strategic plan.
- Assist the Tribes, as needed, to develop a community level syphilis response plan (using the emerging infection disease toolkit and Community based action plan).
- Assist Tribes with promoting local syphilis screening and Iwantthekit-az.com among hard to reach populations (i.e. Tribal jails, substance abuse treatment centers, intimate partner violence shelters, etc.)
- Develop and complete all project-related technical assistance, site visits, work group meetings and training in each of the TEC annual work plans.
- Travel is required within the Phoenix service area (Arizona, Nevada, and Utah) to Tribal partners.

- Demonstrated experience and proficiency with Microsoft Word, Excel, and Power Point. Must be willing to learn other software as needed.
- Demonstrated experience and proficiency in SAS and/or R.
