

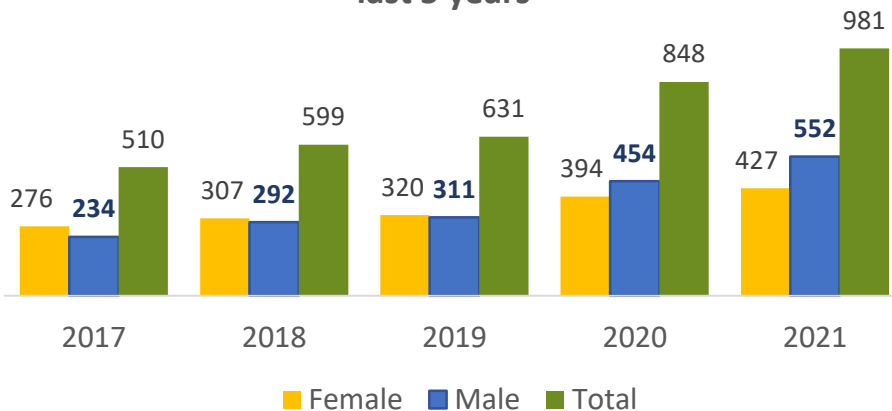
Opioid Abuse and Dependence



Arizona Inpatient Hospital Discharge Data

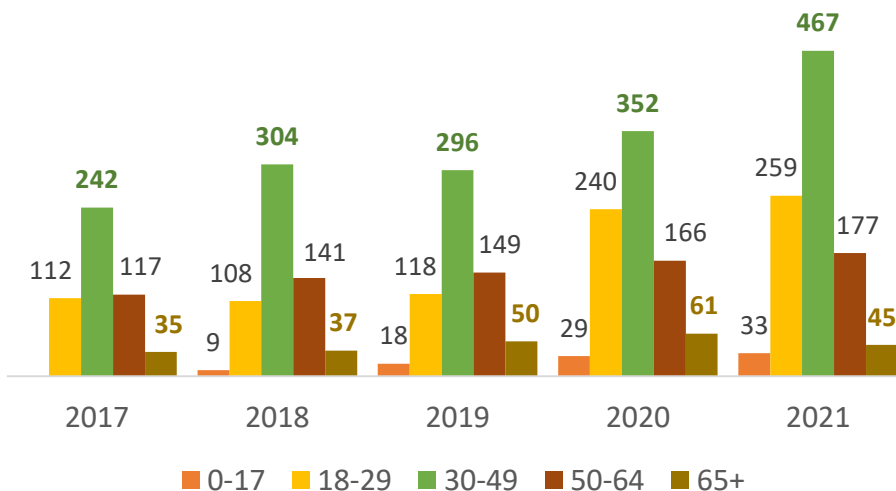
- The charts below were created with the use of patients who identified as American Indian/Alaska Native within the Arizona Department of Health Services hospital reporting system. Information from other hospitals such as Veteran’s Administration and those located on Tribal lands were not included.
- Opioid abuse and dependence is defined as a problematic pattern of opioid use leading to clinically significant impairment or distress. It is categorized with the following ICD-10 codes: F11.1 and F11.2.

Opioid Abuse and Dependence Inpatient Hospital visits have **risen** dramatically over the last 5 years



- In 2020 there was a shift to **males** having more visits than females
- Inpatient visits almost **doubled** from 2017-2021

Opioid Abuse and Dependence Inpatient Hospital visits have **risen** across most age groups



- The **65 plus** age group saw a decrease in visits in 2021
- The **30-49 year old** age group had the most visits each year
