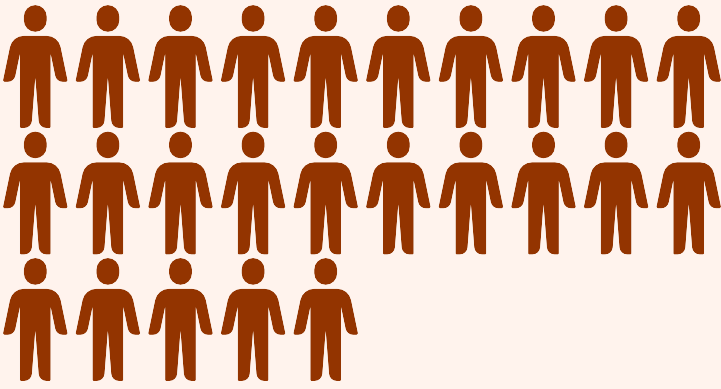
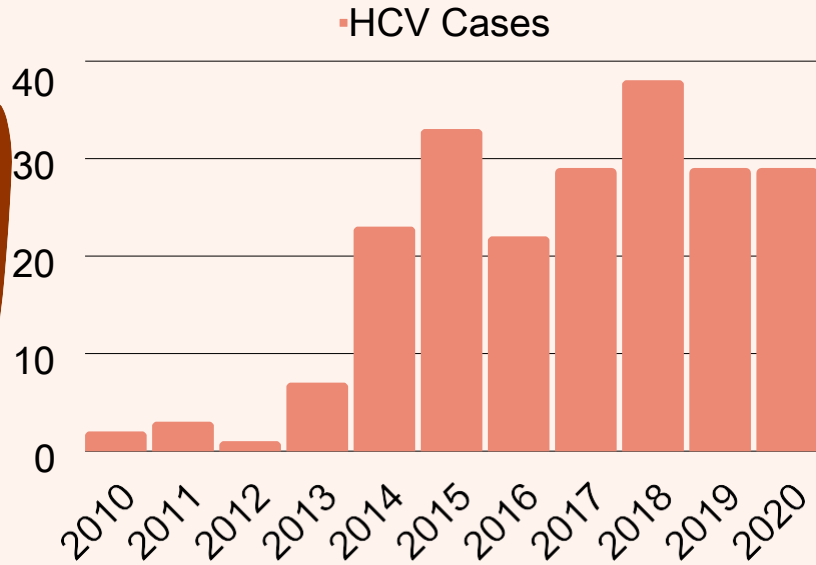


American Indians/Alaska Native Hepatitis C Virus Data in Arizona, Nevada, and Utah

Hepatitis C Virus (HCV) highlights about American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) in Arizona, Nevada, and Utah from ITCA's HIV/STI/HCV Surveillance Report.

HCV CASES IN AZ

From 2010 to 2020, HCV cases among AI/AN increased. There was a reported total of 216 AI/AN diagnosed with HCV.¹



HCV RELATED DEATHS IN NV

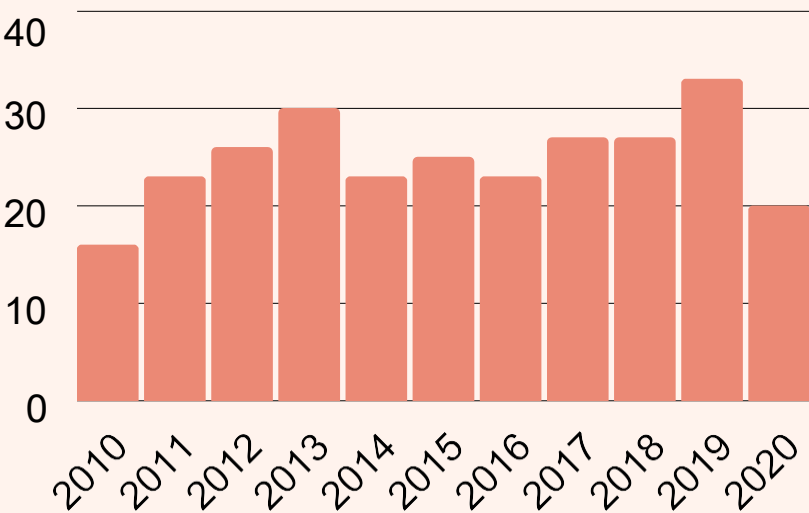
From 2010 to 2019, HCV related deaths among AI/AN remained low. There was a reported total of 25 deaths among AI/AN.¹

ACUTE HCV CASES IN UT

From 2010 to 2020, Acute HCV cases among AI/AN remained low. There was a reported total of 17 AI/AN diagnosed with Acute HCV.¹

CHRONIC HCV CASES IN UT

From 2010 to 2020, Chronic HCV cases among AI/AN increased. There was a reported total of 273 AI/AN with Chronic HCV.¹

How to Prevent HCV?

- Currently there is no vaccine available to prevent HCV¹
- The only way to know you have HCV is to get tested¹
- If you do test positive for HCV, treatment options are available¹
