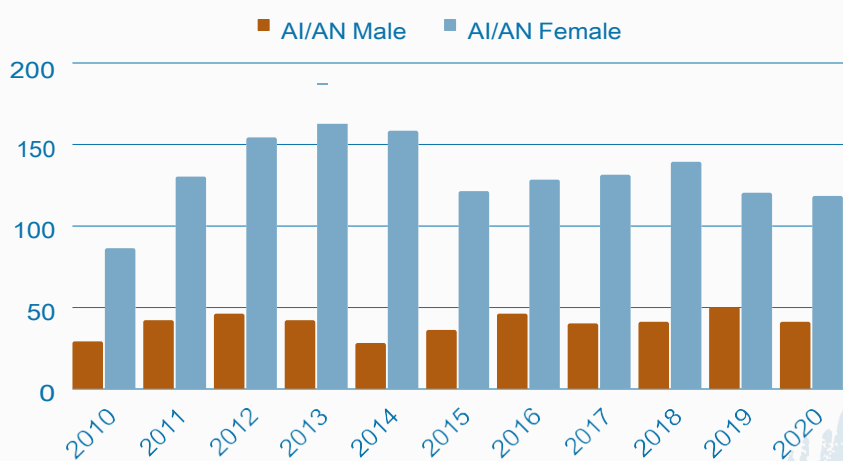


American Indians/Alaska Natives STI Data in Utah

STI highlights about American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) in Utah from ITCA's HIV/STI/HCV Surveillance Report.

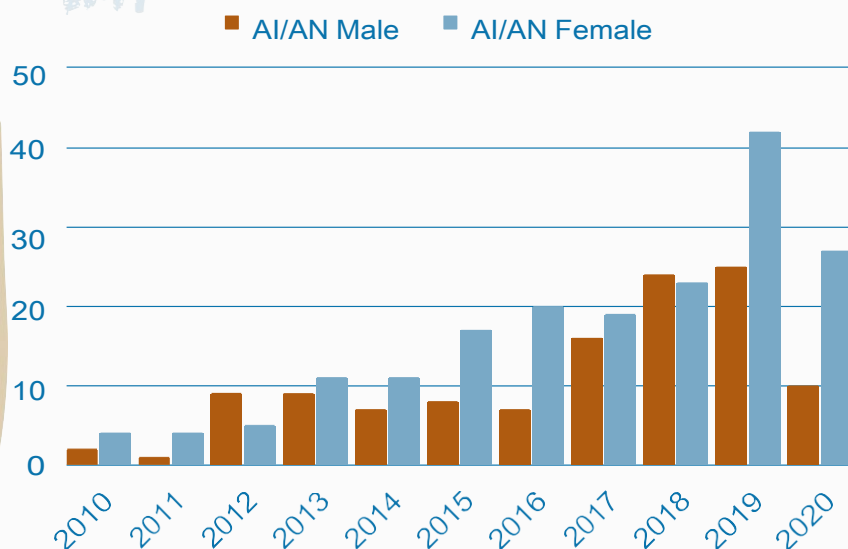


CHLAMYDIA CASES

From 2010 to 2020, Chlamydia cases among AI/AN remained consistent.¹ There were 1,889 AI/AN diagnosed with Chlamydia.¹

GONORRHEA CASES

From 2010 to 2020, Gonorrhea cases among AI/AN increased each year.¹ There were 301 AI/AN diagnosed with Gonorrhea.¹

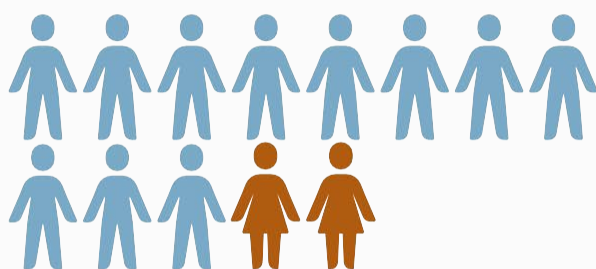


CHLAMYDIA AND GONORRHEA CASES BY GENDER

From 2010 to 2020, AI/AN females had higher cases and incidence rates of Chlamydia and Gonorrhea compared to AI/AN males.¹

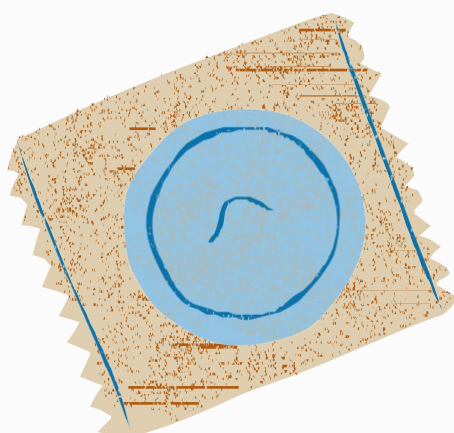
PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SYPHILIS CASES

From 2010 to 2020, Primary and Secondary Syphilis cases among AI/AN increased slightly.¹ There were 13 AI/AN diagnosed with Primary and Secondary Syphilis.¹



How to Prevent STI's

- Get tested for STI's on a regular basis
- Use condoms correctly each time you have sex
- Talk openly with your partners about STI's
