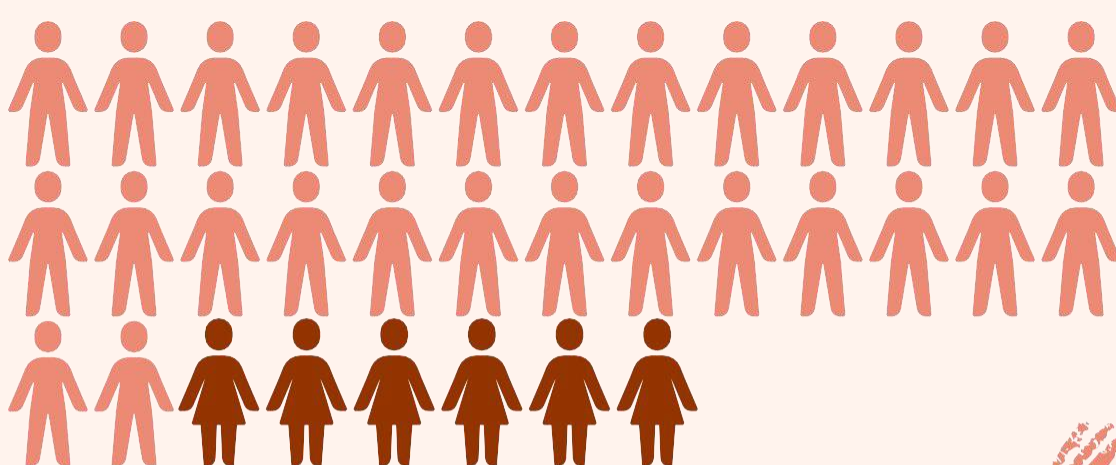


American Indians/Alaska Natives Human Immunodeficiency Virus Data in Nevada

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) highlights about American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) in Nevada from ITCA's HIV/STI/HCV Surveillance Report.

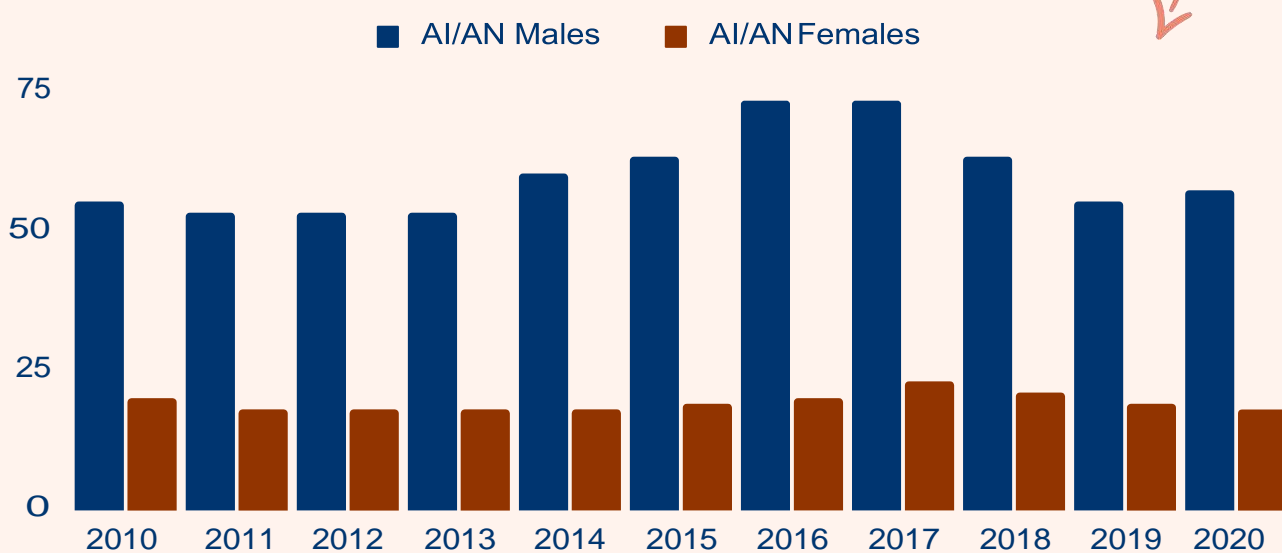
NEW HIV CASES

From 2010 to 2020, HIV cases remained low among AI/AN. There was a reported total of 33 AI/AN diagnosed with HIV. AI/AN males had higher cases and incidence rates of HIV compared to AI/AN females¹



AI/AN LIVING WITH HIV

From 2010 to 2020, the number of AI/AN Living with HIV increased slightly each year. There was a reported total 870 AI/AN living with HIV. Overall, there are more AI/AN males living with HIV compared to AI/AN females.¹



HIV RELATED DEATHS

From 2010 to 2020, the number of HIV related deaths remained very low. There was a reported total of 7 deaths among AI/AN. More AI/AN males have died from HIV related causes compared to AI/AN females.¹

How to Prevent HIV

- Get tested for HIV on a regular basis¹
- Use condoms correctly each time you have sex¹
- Explore alternative options such as PrEP and PEP¹
