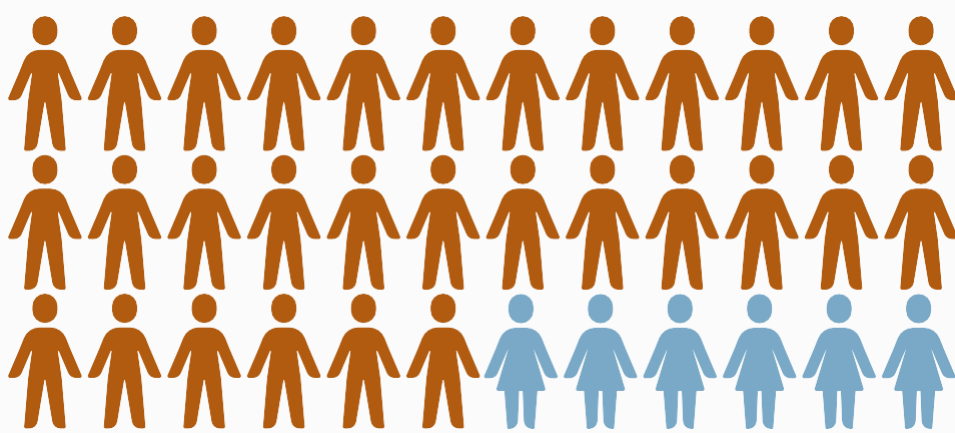


American Indians/Alaska Natives Human Immunodeficiency Virus Data in Utah

Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) highlights about American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) in Utah from ITCA's HIV/STI/HCV Surveillance Report.

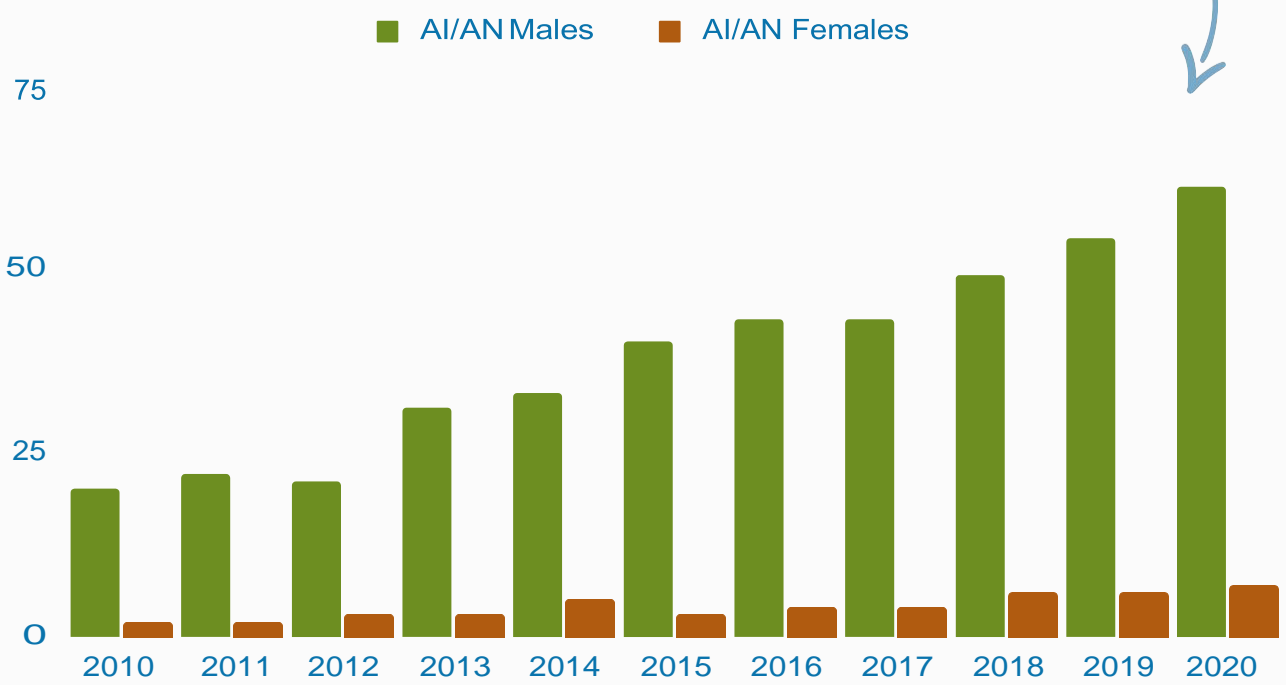
NEW HIV CASES

From 2010 to 2020, new HIV cases remained low among AI/AN. There were 36 AI/AN diagnosed with HIV. AI/AN males had higher cases and incidence rates compared to AI/AN females.¹



AI/AN LIVING WITH HIV

From 2010 to 2020, the number AI/AN Living with HIV increased each year. There were more AI/AN males living with HIV compared to AI/AN females.¹



HIV-RELATED DEATHS

From 2010 to 2020, HIV related deaths among AI/AN remained extremely low. There were 4 HIV related deaths among AI/AN.¹

How to Prevent HIV

- Get tested for HIV on a regular basis¹
- Use condoms correctly each time you have sex¹
- Explore alternative options such as PrEP and PEP¹
