These will be certificate only classes, any attendee wishing to get DEMA issued G400 certificates must register through Acadis. (dematraining.az.gov)

Completion of ICS-300 is a prerequisite. Only individuals enrolled (with prerequisite documentation submitted IS700, IS800, IS100, IS200 certificates from FEMA) approved through Acadis will receive credit and completion certificates from DEMA. If someone who audits the class happens to change their mind later and requests a certificate, DEMA will not be able to issue a certificate to them.
